As you look at 12:1, ponder this statement: "Only God can turn away the anger of God"

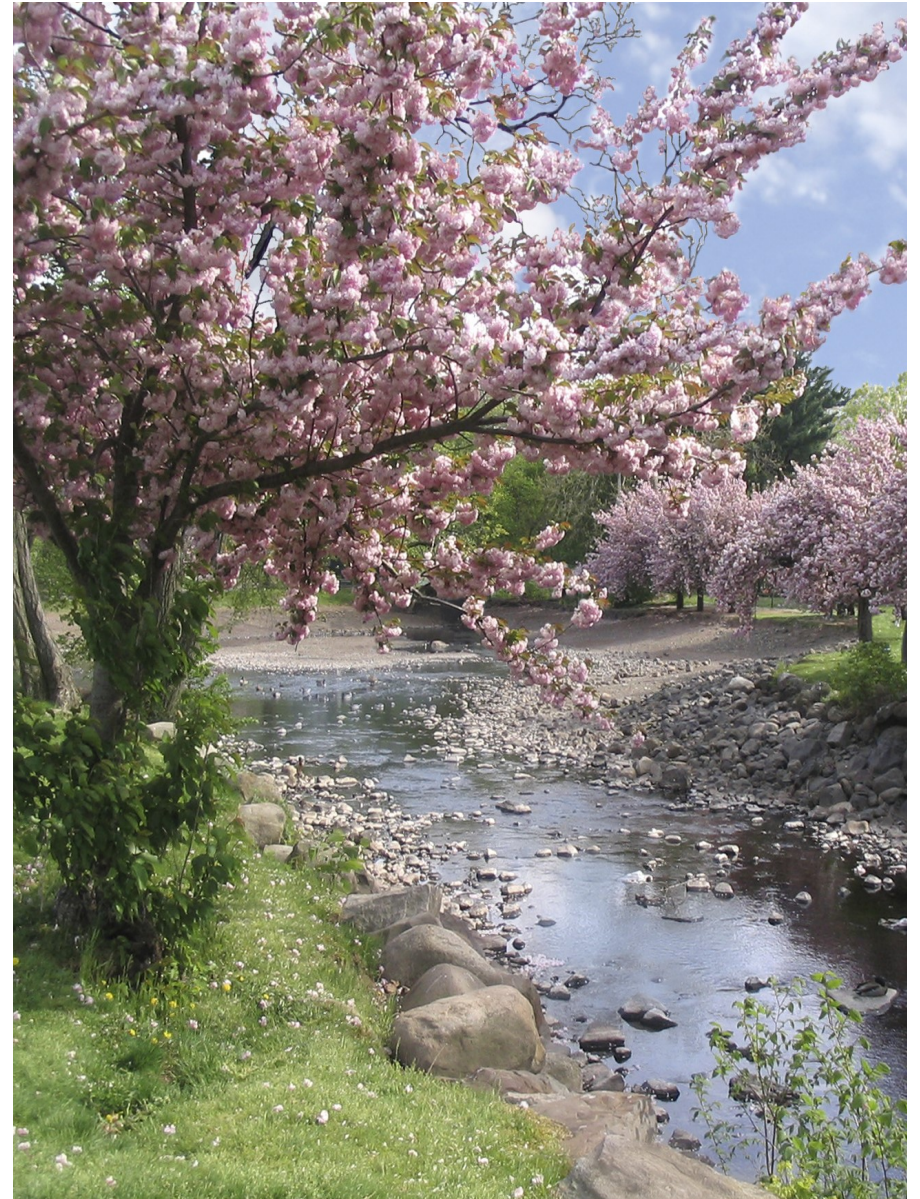
How and where did God accomplish this?
