

10 Keys into the Bible


- 1) love the Bible, 2) read the Bible,

Christians are people with a heart of flesh and a heart of obedience to the Holy Spirit. Christians are going through spiritual battles all their lives: obeying a heart of stone and rejecting God, Of obeying God with a heart of flesh and a new heart?

Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the **Spirit have their minds** set on what the Spirit desires, The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace. (Ro 8:5-6)

New Heart and New Spirit (Ezekiel 36:22-28)

- 1. Begin with God's Holiness
 - a. Be set apart: God is unique to all creation/creatures.
 - b. We should be the same, set apart for God's holiness
- 2. Return to God's homeland
- a. In Christ Jesus: we have to believe in Jesus in order to receive the New Heart and New Spirit
- 3. Receive God's purification:
 - a. through the Holy Spirit & God's Word in Jesus
- 4. Obey and follow God's word: our responsibility
- 5. Enjoy God's new relationship: our new identify
