Welsh Terrier Type Educational Series

The Welsh Terrier Head

Thursday October 6th at 6pm

Hospitality Room, Homewood Suites, 230 Sycamore Road, Breinigsville, PA 1810

Join us for the second in a series of discussions on Welsh Terrier Type. The first was presented by Bruce Schwartz in Louisville (a replay of a similar presentation is available at register.gotowebinar.com). Each subsequent session will focus on a different aspect of Welsh Terrier type.

Type is the essence of a breed and refers to the set of features outlined in the breed standard that define the breed. Without type, the identity of the breed is lost!

On Thursday October 6th there will be an informal discussion on the Welsh Terrier Head. The head is one of the four elements of type. The others are the outline or silhouette, movement, and coat. After a brief review of the standard, there will be an open discussion where participants are asked to share their thoughts and ask questions on the Welsh Terrier Head.

Head: Welsh vs Wire vs Lakeland

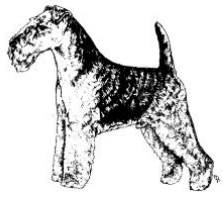


In preparation, think about the following.

1. What is the standard for the Welsh Terrier head?
2. How does the WT differ from the Wire Fox and Lakeland in the following:
 - a. Head shape
 - b. Eye position and shape
 - c. Ears
3. How does the head differ in a dog vs a bitch?
4. What do cheekiness, throatiness, down-faced, dish faced, domed head, snipey muzzle and bumpy skull mean when referring to a Welsh?
5. If you could change one thing about your Welsh Terrier's head, what would it be? If you are a breeder, what strategy would you use to achieve your objective?

Page advertising Instructions

- 2.Attach either a print of your ad or draw up the layout of your ad. Be sure to include all information you would like to see in the ad (including photos and how/where to crop if needed) and where it should be located in your ad.
- 3.If using photos for your advertising, be sure to put your name and address, along with the dog's name on the back of each photograph. Use a label or felt-

tipped pen (ballpoint may damage the photograph).

- 4.If you are sending advertising as "copy ready" on a flash drive, include if it is a full page or a half page ad.

- 5.Prepare and send a self addressed stamped envelope to be used to return your photos.
