April 2025

Greetings to all of you in the Name of Jesus. We trust that you are all well. It seems as though 2025 has just begun, and we are already halfway through April. For us, the past four months have been very busy and filled with many blessings.



First, we had a wonderful time over Christmas and New Year's with our family and friends. Although it was a quick visit, we dedicated most of our time to being with our grandkids. Entering into the New Year surrounded by our whole family set the path for a year filled with hope and joy.



Upon returning to Ghana, we started preparing to move out of the apartment we have been using for the past few years to make way for a new missionary couple with three small children. We spent time packing, cleaning, and giving away items, reducing everything down to a couple of boxes and our traveling suitcases. This marked a new phase in our life and ministry. We would no longer be resident

workers in Ghana but would free ourselves to serve our teams throughout the continent and provide MemberCare for our workers who have been sent. When the new family arrived, we moved into a small guest room at our mission house.



During February, we helped orient the new family to life and ministry in Ghana and facilitated a one-month online training for two units preparing to serve overseas. In March, we spent time with our local Ghana team. Cristina dedicated much energy to organizing the administration of the team,



and we tried to spend individual time with all of our team members, encouraging them and helping them plan and strategize for the future.

Now, at the beginning of April, we have come to Rwanda, where we have been living with a local family and doing an orientation for them to serve in Senegal with the un-reached. It has been very intense as they have three small children. We have had to be flexible with the training times as there always seems to

be something coming up or someone popping in. We have loved the cooler weather in this “land of 1000 hills.”

In May, we will be moving by bus to Uganda. We will again be living with a couple for two weeks who are joining our mission to serve in Asia. Then, we will part ways as Cristina has an international conference in Australia, and I have meetings in Ethiopia and Tanzania. At the end of May, Lord willing, we will meet together on the Island of Mauritius to do another orientation for a young man who will become our local mission mobilizer.

We are excited and blessed to see so many new workers accepting the call of God to serve in spreading the Gospel from Africa to the world.
