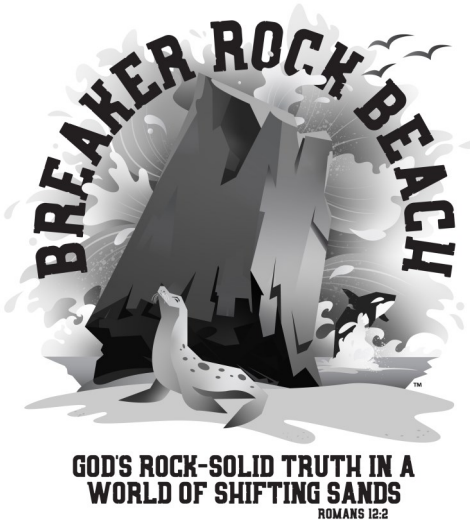
### Camp Cale's Annual Fundraiser!
