11 JUNE 11
"Pickle Baron announces plan to buy
local park"?

12 DEV 12
If the town doesn't raise enough
money to fix the old park equipment
in three days, the city is going to
sell it to Duke Pickler!

13 AL 13
(reading screen)
Dude's gonna demolish our park and
turn it into a Pickle Emporium!

14 JUNE 14
Not on my watch. We gotta stop him
and save the park!

15 SOPHIE 15
I'm in! Let's fight the power!

16 JUNE 16
We will! With cold hard cash!

EXT. JUNE'S NEIGHBORHOOD CUL-DE-SAC - A LITTLE LATER

TIGHT ON June as she uses a sponge to soap up a bicycle.

17 JUNE 17
Bike wash! Come and get your bike
washed! Every cent goes to saving
the Brickyards.

WIDEN TO REVEAL - a KID in a HELMET on the bike. They are at
the top of the FLUME RIDE from "Upside Downer" which is back
intact on June's house. Water sprays down the track. There's
a sign that reads, "BIKE WASH" on the front lawn.

18 JUNE (CONT'D) 18
You're all soaped up and ready for
the spin cycle!

18A They send him off through the loop. The KID <yelps> in 18A
delight. June checks the line of kids who hand money to Dev.

19 DEV 19
Dollar-dollar bills, y'all!

20 JUNE 20
Off to a promising start--

39 JUNE 39
...so the only way we can raise
enough money to save the park is to
bring some of the wonder of
Wonderland to my neighborhood. You
guys in?

41 PEANUT 41
HMMMM... let me check my calendar.

Peanut takes out a CALENDAR and begins slowly leafing through
it. Very methodically. It's taking a while.

42 PEANUT (CONT'D) 42
Mmmmm... mmm-hmmm... hmmm... Wait.
What year is it?

43 STEVE 43
GIVE ME THAT!
(grabs calendar)
There's nothing in here. It's
entirely blank!

44 PEANUT 44
Well, June. It looks like I'm free.

45 JUNE 45
Great. We'll leave at nightfall so
no one sees us.

EXT. WOODS - PORTAL - NIGHT

45A A STREAM OF WONDER CHIMPS exit the portal carrying ALL SORTS 45A
OF STUFF (including) PIECES OF COASTER TRACK. Then June,
Steve, Coop, and Greta exit, pulling a Coaster Car. They
<struggle> to get it through.

46 COOPERTINA 46
<strain> This thing is super heavy!

47 STEVE 47
Why don't we have Boomer pulling it?

48 GRETA 48
(with rope in mouth)
Hey wait a minute. Where's the bear?

48A With one <big effort> they finally get it through... and 48A
Boomer is sitting in the back seat eating popcorn.

49 BOOMER 49
Great ride guys. People in Juneland
are going to love this.

A light goes on in Ms. Downer's house. The front door opens and Ms. Downer comes out, squinting into the night. The impaled Wonder Chimp dances right above her head.

60 JUNE 60
Sorry, Ms. Downer.

61 MS. DOWNER 61
June Bailey, is that you?

62 JUNE 62
Yeah. Just me. By myself.

As she speaks, a Wonder Chimp pulls the lever in the middle of the cul-de-sac bringing the carnival to life. The bright lights BLARE.

63 GUS 63
(quietly)
Busted.

Ms. Downer squints, staring at everyone.

64 MS. DOWNER 64
I can't see a thing without my
glasses! Keep it down out here.
People are trying to sleep!

Ms. Downer slams the door and the Chimp falls off. The other chimps <applaud>.

64A June <breathes a sigh of relief>. 64A

65 JUNE 65
Uh, great work everyone. I'll take
it from here.

CUT TO:

EXT. JUNE'S CUL DE SAC - MORNING

Al rides the roller coaster.

65A AL 65A
Wee-wee!

WIDEN TO REVEAL the whole cul de sac is a bustling carnival now. GAMES, BOOMER PIE STAND, ETC.

(SOPHIE walks around in the BG throughout scene wearing a SANDWICH BOARD SIGN w/ a PICKLE in a RED "NO" SYMBOL.)

66 SOPHIE (THRU MEGAPHONE) 66
(chanting)
Hey-Hey! Ho-Ho! This Pickle Party's
got to go!

67 BUNKY 67
I can't believe you pulled this
off. And you even have the mascots
here without anyone knowing!

68 JUNE 68
Yep. Wanted to let them in on the
fun since they helped make this
happen.

68A They pass PEANUT in the WONDAR MACHINE giving out "fortunes". 68A
June winks at Peanut. Peanut winks back as SOMEONE waits for
their fortune and a BANANA drops out of the slot. The person
looks confused, then peels the banana causing a POP OF
CONFETTI to EXPLODE in his face. The guest <squeals with
delight>.

People are taking pictures with Boomer. He waves silently.
DANIEL ("Detention Club") takes his picture. As soon as June
and Bunky pass, they don't hear him say:

69 DANIEL 69
This bear costume is incredible! It
looks like it has so much padding.
Can you feel this? HIYA!

He karate chops Boomer right in the belly.

70 BOOMER 70
<giggles with delight>

71 DANIEL 71
Or this? HIYA! KEE-YA! WHA-CHA!

71A Daniel continues to wail on Boomer as Boomer <laughs>. 71A

June and Bunky walk by a PETTING ZOO where Greta, Gus, and
Coop are getting a ton of attention/affection in the pen.

72 BUNKY 72
A petting zoo was great cover for
the rest of the crew.

72A GRETA - is on her back, getting her belly scratched by Ms. 72A
Downer. Greta shakes her leg like a dog, <snorting
happily/uncontrollably>.

GUS & COOP - are dancing in front of a KID. They stop. The Kid shoves PELLETS in their mouths filling their cheeks. They resume dancing! The Kid claps.

REVEAL STEVE - by himself, arms crossed in a corner. Someone approaches about to pet him. Steve looks excited, but the person thinks twice and turns away. Steve frumps.

73 JUNE 73
Yeah... I'm not sure Steve's loving
it but, where you gonna put a
porcupine?

74 STEVE 74
(through gritted teeth)
Somewhere with a little more
dignity than this, June.

Sophie and Al run up to June and Bunky.

75 AL 75
This is amazing! Like the time I
found a double hotdog in my corndog!
What-what!

76 SOPHIE (THRU MEGAPHONE) 76
We're doing it! We're sticking it
to "The Man".

Bunky scribble more red onto the Fundraising Thermometer.
It's ONE THIRD OF THE WAY FILLED.

POV - someone watches the kids celebrate from afar...

76B REVEAL - Duke looking out from bushes. He holds TWO PICKLES 76B
up to his eyes like binoculars. He lowers them and takes a
<bite> of a pickle, <chewing it slowly and menacingly>.

ANGLE ON - the Fundraising Thermometer.

MATCH DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. JUNE'S NEIGHBORHOOD CUL-DE-SAC - NIGHT

The Fundraising Thermometer is now JUST OVER HALF FULL. Night has descended over the carnival, but it still bustles. June walks over to Bunky and Al who man a TICKET BOOTH.

77 JUNE 77
Looking good!

Duke looks at Al for a beat, then hands June the paper and she gives it a read. The other kids gather round, concerned.

88 KIDS 88
<curious "Is it true?" walla>

As the kids look at the page we hear a ENGINE REVING O.S..
Neighbors trade confused looks...

89 NEIGHBOR WALLA 89
What's that noise?/Where's that
coming from?

Suddenly, Duke wheelies back into shot in his Pickle Mobile,
which now has a bulldozer shovel on the front. He passes Ms.
Downer who looks up, holding a STUFFED ANIMAL and BALLOON.

90 MS. DOWNER 90
Hey! Being mean to the kids on this
block is my job!

91 DUKE 91
Well, it's mine now!
(Raspberries to the tune of
"Match in the gas tank")
<Raspberry Raspberry Raspberry-
Raspberry-Raspberry Raspberry
Raspberry> Listen up, people. As
much as I hate to ruin everyone's
fun, this charity case carnival has
gone on long enough.
(then)
Who am I kidding... I'm going to
enjoy knocking this down. It's dill-
dozing time!

Duke drives toward the carnival as confused Neighbors move
aside.

92 JUNE AND THE KIDS 92
No!!!!

Suddenly, the bulldozer shovel comes loose, <grinding> on the
pavement, forcing the golf cart to a stop.

93 DUKE 93
WHAT?!!!

ANGLE ON GUS & COOP who each hold a DRILL. They tail five.

They scamper back to the petting zoo as Duke continues:

95 DUKE (CONT'D) 95
You kids got lucky! I'll be back
first thing tomorrow! See you at
day break, dill weeds!
 (like a car backing up)
<raspberry> <raspberry> <raspberry>
<raspberry> <raspberry> <raspberry>

He begins to back the golf cart out, <loudly dragging> the
loosely attached shovel. It's a long awkward exit. The crowd
is silent with confusion...

96 JUNE 96
Agh. There's gotta be something we
can do. We just need one more day
with this carnival and--

97 BUNKY 97
 (pulling June aside)
June, I know how you get, but if we
don't get all this stuff back to
Wonderland tonight, Duke Pickler's
gonna doze it in the morning!

97A June looks around at all the Wonderland stuff and the 97A
mascots, <sighing> resigned to this truth.

98 JUNE 98
I'm beginning to really dislike
pickles.

EXT. JUNE'S NEIGHBORHOOD CUL-DE-SAC - NIGHT - LATER

98A The carnival has been completely dismantled. June watches 98A
Wonder Chimps carry the last track pieces back to Wonderland,
taking in the sight with a <sigh>. Boomer comes up and puts
his hand on her shoulder.

99 BOOMER 99
Everyone is really proud of you for
trying to save your park that's not
our park. Though I guess you're
saving stuff from our park now,
which is technically yours too so--
wait, you have two parks?!

100 GRETA 100
Don't hurt yourself there big bear.
 (to June)
You're doing the right thing June.

109 MS. DOWNER 109
You kids gonna open this bike wash
or what? Me and the gals are tryna
get a ride in and it's almost
dinner time.

110 BUNKY 110
(quietly to June)
It's 8:30 in the morning.

111 JUNE 111
Do all these people want their
bikes washed?

112 DAD (O.S.) 112
Yup! And so do we!

June turns to see Mom and Dad walking out of the garage with
their old bikes. June smiles...

Suddenly, the <pickle horn> rings out as everyone turns to
see Duke driving up with his blade-outfitted pickle mobile.
He comes to a screeching halt in front of everyone.

113 DUKE 113
(big sniff)
I love the smell of dill-doing in
the morning.
(bites pickle then,
noticing)
Wait... where's the carnival? Ya
know what, doesn't matter. You
didn't raise enough money to thwart
my pickle plan. Brickyards park is
mine! <bites pickle>

114 MS. DOWNER 114
Hey Bailey, you gonna wash this
bike or what?

Ms. Downer holds up a crisp HUNDRED DOLLAR BILL.

115 DUKE 115
One hundred dollars?! What? That's
not what a bike wash costs!

Suddenly, the whole line of neighbors starts pulling out
money and holding it up.

117 NEIGHBOR WALLA 117
Me next!/I need a wash!/My bike's
dirty too!
