EXT. GRETA'S BARN - DAY

1A STEVE <whistles> as he places SAFTEY CONES, absent-mindedly placing one on a WONDER CHIMP. The cone scampers away. His attention is clearly divided as he side eyes... 1A

1B/C JUNE and GRETA standing outside Greta's barn <laughing>. 1B/C

1D GRETA
Later <snort>.

1E JUNE
Later <snort>.

They butt bump. As June walks away Steve runs up to her.

1 JUNE 1
Oh hey, Steve. How's it goin--

2 STEVE 2
Yes, everything's wondrous and delightful. So, you and Greta tell each other everything, right?

3 JUNE 3
Pretty much! We're like two hogs in a--

4 STEVE 4
Terrific! I was wondering if you guys ever talk about... uhh.

4B JUNE 4B
(knowing smile)
You?

The chimp <squeaks> in the background.

4C STEVE 4C
What? No. I would never wanna-- has she?

8 JUNE 8
Steve, what Greta and I talk about stays between us, but... I don't think it would be the worst thing in the world for *you* to go talk to *her*.

9 STEVE 9
Spontaneous is not my thing, June. Plan, plan, and rehearse that plan is what I say-

10 GRETA 10
Hey, Steve!

16 STEVE 16
Ah! Oh uh, hey Greta. How are you
on this fine-- DO YOU WANNA HANG
OUT TONIGHT?! <gasp>

Steve immediately covers his mouth.

17 GRETA 17
You mean, like just the two of us.
Like... a solo hang?

18 STEVE 18
<GULP> Yes...?

19 GRETA 19
Sure. I can't wait to see what you
have planned!

20 STEVE 20
Haha! Brilliant! This is so...
(realizing) Did you say "planned"?

21 GRETA 21
Ha! <SNORT> Yeah, like you'd ever
do anything like this without
planning for months.

21A STEVE 21A
<gasp>

Steve turns to June who smiles reassuringly.

22 JUNE 22
(stage whisper)
You'll be fine.

23 STEVE 23
Indeed. I am Mr. Plan, so naturally
I must have the planniest plan ever
planned <heh>.
(beat then)
Well, I got a safety thing that I
need to safety that June needs to
safety with me. So... Cheerio!

24A Steve scampers off, dragging June away. 24A

EXT. PILE 'O FRUIT SMOOTHIE BAR - MOMENTS LATER

24B Steve sits at the bar with June, <breathing into a PAPER BAG.>24B

25 STEVE 25
A SOLO HANG?! Greta and I hanging
out? Alone? What have I done?!

29A Steve <breathes> into his bag again. 29A

30 JUNE 30
Don't worry, Steve. I'll help you
plan the best solo hang in the
history of solo hangs. We can even
rehearse it so you're comfortable.

31 STEVE 31
How do you rehearse a solo hang?

33 PEANUT (O.S., AS PAPER BAG) 33
Ahhh... The solo hang.

33A JUNE/STEVE 33A
Ah!

34A/B Steve pulls the bag away from his mouth as it somehow begins 34A/B
to "speak". Then throws the bag in shock as Peanut somehow
crawls out of it.

35 PEANUT 35
The true sign of blossoming like-
like. L'comme-comme. *Steve and
Greta sitting in a tree, like-like-
like-like-I-N-G...*

36 STEVE 36
Preposterous! You'd never find me
sitting in a tree. Branch crackage
is the leading cause of most branch-
related injuries.

37 PEANUT 37
Don't be ashamed. To like-like is
the most beautiful thing that can
happen between a hog and a cactus.

38 STEVE 38
I'm not a cactu-- you know what, I
have bigger fish to fry.

39 PEANUT 39
June! Did you know cactuses can fry
fish?

42 JUNE 42
Uhh sure Peanut. I have an idea and
your Wonder Chimp making services
are needed.

43 PEANUT 43
You need a Chimpan-pants-maker to
make custom pants for everyone?

Peanut holds up a pair of pants.

44 JUNE 44
Put a pin in that one. Cause right
now we need a solo-hang-test-chimp.
So Steve can practice for his solo
hang with Greta.

45 PEANUT 45
Anything in the name of like-like.

Peanut climbs back into the paper bag. The top cinches. It
inflates and <POPS> in a burst of CONFETTI. Peanut is gone.

45A JUNE 45A
Alright. Now we just gotta find
something fun to do with Greta.

50 STEVE 50
Fun? Oh-ho-ho say no more.

INT. LE QUILLE CLUB - MOMENTS LATER

TIGHT ON: Steve and June.

51 STEVE 51
Behold!

Widen to reveal:

A wall of shelves full of ORANGE SAFETY CONES of all
different varieties and sizes displayed like trophies.

52 STEVE (CONT'D) 52
My Safety Cone Collection! What
could be more fun than sharing the
long and exciting history of each
and every cone with Greta? Because
who doesn't love cones?

53 JUNE 53
I feel like if I answer that
question it'll hurt your confidence.

54 STEVE 54
You'll see once we get this test
going. Speaking of which, where's
Peanut with the--

55 PEANUT (PRE-LAP O.S.) 55
Solo-hang-test-chimp?
Peanut rises up from under a cone, wearing it as a hat.

56 PEANUT (CONT'D) 56
Presenting... JULIET...
Peanut grabs and flips over another cone, revealing his special new Wonder Chimp: JULIET.

57 PEANUT (CONT'D) 57
A perfect beauty. Schooled in the arts and sciences. Speaks eleven languages--
Juliet FARTS. (Her farts are all adorable CUTE TOOTS.)

58 PEANUT (CONT'D) 58
You're right, Juliet.
(aloud to Steve/June)
She said she's bored.
(whisper to Steve/June)
She's most fluent in fart.
Steve raises a brow at June. June nods enthusiastically.

59 STEVE 59
(awkwardly interacting w/ Juliet)
Um, righty then. So uh, should I call you "Greta" or "Juliet" or...
(Juliet FARTS)
You know what, let's not use names.
<achem> Test commencing. Presenting cone collection. And... begin: Each fascinating cone on display has a--
(Juliet FARTS)
--story. This cone, for example, is nicked because a guest dropped--
(Juliet FARTS)
--their keys.
(off Juliet's FART)
Is that the bored fart again? Ah!

As they speak, a SEVERAL SHELVES OF CONES topple onto Steve. Nobody sees what knocked them over.

59A JUNE 59A
Is everyone all right? How'd that happen? <running walla>
We pan to the corner seeing a CHIMP-LIKE SILHOUETTE WITH A FLOWING MANE OF HAIR hidden in the shadows.

61 STEVE 61
Gah! My fragile indestructible
cones! This plan is a failure. My
solo hang will be a disaster!

62 JUNE 62
Maaaybe instead of doing something
very specific you like, we should
try something everybody likes.

63 STEVE 63
<gasp> Like clipboards?

64 JUNE 64
I was thinking more like... food.

EXT. ENTRANCE TOWN/MAIN STREET - LATER

<WHIRRRRR>... Steve and Juliet cruise along in his golf cart.

65 STEVE 65
I think June's idea for us to
practice having a meal together is
splendid. I definitely need to work
on my small talk.

They drive past a BUSH. We hear a <small whirring motor>.
CLOSE ON - WIDEN TO REVEAL a TINY HAND HELD FAN is blowing a
flowing mane of hair sticking out of the top of the bush.
(The hair is attached to the head of a Chimp hiding in the
bush.)

EXT. WAFFLE SHACK - CONTINUOUS

They pull up at the Waffle Shack. Steve and Juliet approach
June who is acting as the maitre'd.

66 JUNE 66
Welcome to the Waffle Shack. I have
our finest table right this way.

67 STEVE 67
Ooh! Nicely done, June. When Greta
and I do this tonight, that will
feel quite sophisticated.

Juliet <FARTS>. June seats Steve and Juliet at a table.
Juliet is too short to be seen.

68 STEVE (CONT'D) 68
Uh, perhaps we could get a booster
seat for the lady?

69 JUNE 69
Right away, fine porcu-sir.

As June puts a booster seat under Juliet, Steve's chair leg <SNAPS>, and he drops to the floor.

70 STEVE 70
<oof> Well, if that wasn't embarrassing...

71 JUNE 71
I'm so sorry. Let me get you another chair. I'll double check all of them before your solo hang with Greta. I don't know how that could have happened.

As June replaces Steve's chair...

At a nearby table, a FLOWING MANE billows from atop/behind a menu as a figure tucks in a cartoonishly large CHAINSAW underneath the table.

June replaces Steve's chair. Peanut emerges from behind table wearing the DOME COVER of a serving platter on his head.

72 PEANUT 72
(muffled)
Do you want to hear the specials?

Peanut takes the dome cover off.

73 STEVE 73
<clears throat> Sure. Tell us about the specials.

74 PEANUT 74
It's waffles. Special waffles.

75 STEVE 75
Are they special because they're different from the waffles normally served here at the Waffle Shack?

76 PEANUT 76
No, they're just waffles. Would you like to look at a menu?

77 STEVE 77
Why not?

78 PEANUT 78
Because it just says, "Waffles".

79 STEVE 79
Ok, I'll have the waffles.

80 PEANUT 80
Excellent. We're out of waffles.

Peanut puts the dome cover back on and exits.

There's an awkward pause between Steve and Juliet.

81 STEVE 81
So, do you have any hobbies?
(off Juliet's FART, to self)
Stupid question, Steve. She was
created literally minutes ago.
<sniffing>

Steve catches a whiff of Juliet's latest toot, and looks surprised... delighted even.

82 STEVE (CONT'D) 82
I feel strange saying this, but
your flatulence smells quite
lovely. Like cotton candy.

Juliet smiles and gives a longer <HIGH-PITCH/SQUEAKY TOOT>.

83 STEVE (CONT'D) 83
You're welcome? Hey! I understand
that. I'm starting to speak fart.
We're... connecting...?

Juliet raises a Wonder Gulp cup as if asking for a toast.
Steve smiles and raises his. <CLINK>

84 STEVE (CONT'D) 84
To a test meal that's going quite
well. Greta best be preparing
herself for the solo hang of her
life.

Peanut, under the dome cover, hides behind the table.

85 PEANUT 85
(muffled)
Oh, I've seen to that...

CUT TO:

EXT. WONDERLAND - ENTRANCE TOWN - SAME

Greta stands by a PANTS CART as a CHIMPAN-PANTS-MAKER
measures her for pants and shows her FABRIC SWATCHES.

86 GRETA 86
Why are you measuring me for
pants?! I don't wear pants.
(suddenly delighted re: a swatch)
Oh, is this pleather? Does it come in
a break away? I'm a hog on the go.

EXT. WAFFLE SHACK - RESUME

86A/B June watches as Steve and Juliet share a <chuckle>. 86A/B

87 JUNE 87
Hm. So far, so good. Time to test
the evening's entertainment.

June gives a signal and the CHIMPANBAND begins to <play>.
Juliet immediately lights up and begins <tooting> along with
the music.

88 STEVE 88
Oh! You play music? I've always had
great appreciation of the wind
section.

Nearby, the "Flowing Mane" pounds his fist in anger. June
sidles over to Steve and they have a whispered exchange:

89 JUNE 89
Looks like this test is going well.

90 STEVE 90
It is. Juliet said she's having the
best night of her life. Ignoring
it's the first night of her life,
that's solid feedback. Still, I
feel like something's missing.

91 JUNE 91
Could that something be... Greta?

92 STEVE 92
She *is* the one I like-like. <gasp>
I said it out loud. I should plan
how I'm going to say it to her. I
like-like you.

Just then the "Flowing Mane" dramatically reveals himself.
FLO-MEO is an incredibly muscular Wonder Chimp (think
shirtless Thor). He flips a table over.

93 WONDER CHIMP (FLO-MEO) 93
Flo-meo like-likes Juliet!

Flo-meo lunges and attacks Steve! *(NOTE: Flo-meo will continue to point the fan at his hair throughout rest of the episode.)*

94 STEVE 94
AHHHHH!

Flo-meo chases Steve around the restaurant.

95/A STEVE & JUNE 95/A
Peanut, what did you do!?!

96 PEANUT 96
What? Do you think I could make a Juliet without making her Flo-meo?

96A STEVE 96A
<yelps>

98 WONDER CHIMP (FLO-MEO) 98
Flo-meo like-likes Juliet!

99 PEANUT 99
A pair of Star-crossed like-likers.

100 JUNE 100
Peanut, there is SO much to unpack there.

Steve dodges Flo-meo's attack, knocking over a table.

100A STEVE 100A
<yelping/dodging walla>

101 JUNE 101
But first we have to save Steve!

Flo-meo rushes Steve. Steve hops in his golf cart and flees.

101A STEVE 101A
<long yell>

Flo-meo chases after him.

June runs after them.

EXT. WONDERLAND, VARIOUS LOCATIONS - CONTINUOUS

ON STEVE - Driving recklessly as Flo-meo chases. Unfortunately, Flo-meo is faster than the golf cart. He catches up, and lifts the back of the golf cart so the wheels spin uselessly. He picks up the golf cart and tosses it aside.

103 STEVE 103
Blimey, the muscles on you...
(off Flo-meo chasing him)
AHHHHHHH!

Steve continues fleeing.

104 STEVE (CONT'D) 104
I don't like-like Juliet! I was
talking about Greta!

They race off screen.

EXT. WONDERLAND, FIREWORKS FALLS - CONTINUOUS

Flo-meo catches up to Steve, and slings him over one
shoulder.

105 STEVE 105
AHHHH!

Flo-meo thrusts the fan into Steve's hand, adjusting it so it
aims at his hair, continuing to blow it.

106 STEVE (CONT'D) 106
I am NOT going to hold your fan!
(appreciating)
Wow, I mean that flow is
remarkable. OK.

Steve continues to hold the fan, dangling precariously as Flo-
meo climbs the Falls.

107 STEVE (CONT'D) 107
This is very bad timing. I should
be rendezvousing with Greta soon.
(gives up struggling)
What's the point? It's clear that
my plan was a failure. The solo
hang with Greta would have been a
failure too.

108 WONDER CHIMP (FLO-MEO) 108
Flo-meo like-likes Juliet.

111 STEVE 111
But how do you know if she like-
likes you back? The two of you are
so different...
(realizing)
...and yet you were made for each
other. Literally. Maybe opposites
do attract.
(MORE)

STEVE (CONT'D)

Maybe a cautious safety porcupine
like me and a spontaneous thrill
seeking hog like her can actually
hang... solo.

EXT. WONDERLAND, FIREWORKS FALLS - TOP - CONTINUOUS

They reach the top of the falls. Flo-meo tosses Steve onto
the cliff.

112 STEVE 112
<efforts> Thanks for the talk.
You've really given me hope.

Flo-meo lifts Steve over his head, and walks towards the
edge.

113 STEVE (CONT'D) 113
And you're still going to launch me
to my doom! <Ahh!>

Flo-meo edges closer to the drop off. Steve shouts to all of
Wonderland:

117 STEVE (CONT'D) 117
*Greta, I'm at the top of Fireworks
Falls being thrown to my demise by a
Wonder Chimp... with stunning,
absolutely stunning hair! Save me...*

EXT. WONDERLAND - ENTRANCE TOWN - SAME

118 STEVE (O.S., THRU MEGAPHONE (CONT'D)) 118
...GRETA! SAVE ME!

Greta stands by the Pants Cart now wearing a BREAK-AWAY TRACK
PANTS as she listens intently.

119 GRETA 119
Oh! It's on! Which means these are
off! Break-away!

Greta rips off her (snapping) break-away pants and bolts off.
Beat. She runs back in, talking to the Chimpan-pants-maker
before bolting off again.

120 GRETA (CONT'D) 120
I'll take two of these in red.
Thanks!
