INT. PLAYHOUSE  
(OPENING; CONT'D)

SCENE 2

(THE UNSEEN CHOIR LEADER  
GIVES THE KEY WITH A  
PITCH PIPE AND  
A CHOIR OF MILITARY  
CADETS SING A HARMONIOUS  
MADRIGAL, ACAPELLA.)

CHOIR

Oh, it's Christmas in the playhouse  
And our hearts are all a glow  
As we welcome you to the playhouse  
And to Pee-wee's Christmas Special  
Oh, the holidays are here again  
Peace on earth, good will and cheer  
And we wish you a Seasons Greetings  
At this special time...of year.

(THE CHOIR DIRECTOR TURNS  
AROUND, IT'S PEE-WEE. HE  
SCREAMS:

PEE WEE

Christmas!

(THE MUSIC JUMPS INTO A  
SWINGING BEAT AS PEE-WEE  
CONTINUES.)

PEE WEE

Hello, everybody! My name's Pee-wee.  
What's YOURS!...Welcome to my very  
special Christmas special. Starring...  
Me! Pee-wee Herman! And...

(AS PEE-WEE SHOUTS EACH  
NAME THE PLAYHOUSE  
CHARACTERS APPEAR ON  
CAMERA, DANCING.)

SCENE 4

And my special, special guest stars...

(THE CELEBRITIES HEAD'S  
APPEAR CHROMA KEYED ON  
CHRISTMAS BALLS.)

PEE WEE

SCENE 4A - 4Q

(CELBRTITY LIST TO COME.)

(ON PEE-WEE AS HE SINGS:)

SCENE 5

PEE WEE

(SINGING)

Oh, it's Christmas in the Playhouse.

And we're gonna have a lot of fun.

Merry Christmas everybody.

Merry Christmas every one!

(HE HOLDS THE LAST NOTE  
UNTIL HE TURNS BLUE. THE  
MUSIC FINALLY CUTS OFF:)

PEE WEE

SCENE 5  
(cont)

Ha. Ha. Ha.

(END OPENING)

(COMMERCIAL #1)

ACT 1

(INT. - LIVING ROOM)  
(PEE-WEE LEANS INTO  
CAMERA)

PEE-WEE

Merry Christmas! Ahhh! I love  
Christmas. You know the most important  
thing about Christmas don't you?  
That's right...Presents!!! And I'm  
just adding to my list for Santy  
Claus...Let's see...where was I Conky?

CONKY

M-m-m-moped.

PEE-WEE

Oh yeah, a moped...and I want a wood  
burning kit...make that, a deluxe wood  
burning kit.

(PEE-WEE PACES BACK AND  
FORTH AS HE THINKS OF  
ADDITIONS TO HIS  
CHRISTMAS LIST. DICTATING  
TO CONKY)

PEE-WEE

A new space helmet...walkie talkies...  
uh...

PEE-WEE

(TO CAMERA)

What would you put on my list if you  
were me?

(ACTING LIKE HE HEARS THE  
HOME AUDIENCE)

SCENE 6  
(cont)

PEE WEE

A new car?...Cooking utensils?...  
Cash!? Good idea. That's always a  
practical gift...A yo-yo?!  
Okay...Conky, put down yo-yo.

CONKY

B-B-But P-P-Pee-wee, you already have  
a yo-yo.

PEE-WEE

I do? Are you sure?

CONKY

Affirmative, Pee-wee. Yo-yo: Toy  
inventory number 5-4-7-2-9-54-9.

(PEE-WEE WALKS OVER TO A  
SECRET DOOR LOCATED  
UNDERNEATH THE STAIRCASE.  
HE ENTERS THE NUMBER INTO  
THE KEYPAD. HE NOTICES  
THE CAMERA WATCHING.)

PEE WEE

Turn around...

(CAMERA PANS AWAY FOR A  
BEAT.)

PEE WEE (O.C.)

Okay...

(CAMERA TURNS BACK ON  
HIM)  
(THE DOOR SLIDES UP  
REVEALING REVOLVING  
SHELVES LIKE A JEWELRY

DISPLAY CASE HOLDING A  
COLLECTION OF INTERESTING  
AND UNUSUAL TOYS.)  
(THE SHELVES STOP AND  
PEE-WEE PICKS UP HIS YO-  
YO.)

SCENE 6  
(cont)

PEE WEE

Look. I do have a yo-yo.

(HE BEGINS TO PLAY WITH  
THE YO-YO.)

PEE WEE

Walk the dog!

(THE YO-YO SPROUTS LEGS  
AND STARTS TO WALK AND  
BARK.)

SCENE 6A

PEE WEE

Round the world!

(IT SPROUTS WINGS AND  
SPINS AROUND GLOBEY.)

SCENE 6  
(cont)

SCENE 6B

GLOBEY

Stop it, Pee-wee. The yo-yo is  
annoying me.

SCENE 6  
(cont)

PEE-WEE

Look out at home!

(HE HURLS THE YO-YO INTO  
CAMERA, CRACKING THE  
LENS.)

PEE WEE

Uh-oh. Conky, you'd better put a new  
camera on the list. Ha. Ha.

## PEE WEE (CONT'D)

SCENE 6  
(cont)

Alright Conky, in conclusion, add to that a pup tent, football, a new train, a set of encyclopedias and one of those dolls you fill up with that gooey goopy stuff...Sign it, most sincerely yours...especially during the holiday season...your pal... who's been very, very, very good all this whole year...Pee-wee...I'm not kidding how good I've been...

Herman...P.S....

I really have been good, please believe me, Santa, please. Please and thank you. I've practically been an angel...P.P.S...Please add this list to the other lists I sent you dated, February 16, August 5, and the September telegram, as well...Got all that, Conky?

CONKY

G-g-gee Pee-wee. Do you think you asked for enough?

PEE-WEE

SCENE 6  
(cont.)

No, but I didn't want to appear  
greedy. Ha. Ha. Okay, print that out,  
will ya, Conky?

(CONKY WHIRS AND SPUTTERS  
AS AN ENDLESS TICKER TAPE  
PRINT OUT EMERGES.)

MISS YVONNE (O.C.)

SCENE 7

Looks like someone's making out  
another Christmas list.

(MISS YVONNE IS STANDING  
OUTSIDE THE WINDOW.)

PEE WEE

Hi, Miss Yvonne. Merry Christmas.

MISS YVONNE

And the merriest of Christmas's to  
you, Pee-wee. I brought you a present.

PEE-WEE

A present?! Come on in!

(PEE-WEE OPENS THE DOOR  
FOR MISS YVONNE WHO IS  
DRESSED FOR THE HOLIDAY  
AND WITH A CHRISTMAS TREE  
HAIRDO. SHE CARRIES A  
PRESENT.)

MISS YVONNE

Thank you, Pee-wee.

(PEE-WEE IS FIXED ON THE  
PRESENT, BARELY ABLE TO  
CONTAIN HIMSELF FROM  
GRABBING IT OUT OF HER  
HANDS.)

MISS YVONNE

SCENE 7  
(cont)

Well? Aren't you going to say anything  
about my new hairdo?

(THE LIGHT BULBS IN HER  
HAIR LIGHT UP)

PEE WEE

Wow! It's really Christmassy, Miss  
Yvonne. But what's that plant hanging  
on it?

(MISS YVONNE KISSES HIM  
ON THE CHEEK.)

MISS YVONNE

It's mistletoe. You are always  
supposed to kiss someone when they  
stand under the mistletoe. This way,  
I'm insured of hundred and hundreds of  
kisses from everyone.

PTERRI

Kiss me, Miss Yvonne.

MAGIC SCREEN

Me too.

CHAIRRY

Kiss me.

FISH

Come over here and give us a wet kiss.

SCENE 7A

MISS YVONNE

SCENE 7  
(cont)

Don't worry. There's enough of me for everyone.

PEE-WEE

Excuse me, Miss Yvonne...

But before you start makin' out with everybody in the playhouse, may I please have my present.

MISS YVONNE

Oh, of course. Here you are.

(SHE HANDS HIM THE GIFT WHICH IS VERY HEAVY.)

PEE WEE

Wow. It's really heavy. What is it a gold bar?

MISS YVONNE

No, but it's just as priceless. It's my special, home made Christmas fruitcake.

(PEE-WEE GRIMACES)

PEE WEE

Fruitcake...

(HE BANGS IT ON THE COUNTER WITH A THUD-THUD)

PEE WEE

Thanks, Miss Yvonne.

MISS YVONNE

SCENE 7  
(cont)

Your welcome, Pee-wee.

PEE-WEE

I have a little present for you, too.

(HE HANDS HER A SMALL  
GIFT)

PEE WEE

It's perfume. "Eau de Pee-wee."

MISS YVONNE

Oh, my favorite! It smells just like  
you. Thank you, Pee-wee.

(SHE KISSES HIM AGAIN)

FLOORY

SCENE 7B

Hey, Miss Yvonne. Come stand over here.

MISS YVONNE

SCENE 7  
(cont)

Coming Floory, darling.

(MISS YVONNE APPLIES MORE  
LIPSTICK AS SHE EXITS TO  
THE BEDROOM)

PEE WEE

I'd better put this brick, I mean  
fruitcake, in the refridgerator before  
it gets any harder.

(PEE WEE LUGS THE  
FRUITCAKE TO THE KITCHEN  
AND OPENS THE  
REFRIDGERATOR DOOR.)

CUT TO:

(INT. REFRIDGERATOR)

SCENE 8

(AS PEE-WEE OPENS THE REFRIDGERATOR, ALL THE FRUITS AND VEGATABLES ARE HAVING A CHRISTMAS DAY PARADE. OR SOME OTHER CHRISTMAS ACTIVITY WHICH WE'RE NOT ALREADY DOING)

(INT. KITCHEN)

SCENE 9

(AS THERE'S NO ROOM IN THE REFRIDGERATOR, HE PLACES THE FRUITCAKE ON THE COUNTER.)

(ANGLE ON THE PICTURE PHONE AS IT RINGS.)

PEE WEE

I'll get it! I'll get it!

(INT. PICTURE PHONE)

SCENE 10

(PEE-WEE ENTERS AND PULLS DOWN A BACKDROP WHICH LOOKS LIKE SANTA'S WORKSHOP. HE ANSWERS.)

PEE WEE

Merry Christmas. Pee-wee's Playhouse.

Pee-wee speaking...

(A CELEBRITY #1 IS ON THE PICTURE PHONE SCREEN)

SCENE 10A

CELEBRITY #1

Hi, Pee-wee. Merry Christmas. I was just calling to see if I could be on your Christmas Special.

PEE WEE

I'm awfully sorry, CELEBRITY #1, but I've already booked too many stars as it is.

SCENE 10  
(cont)

CELEBRITY #1

Oh...Well, what about next Christmas?

SCENE 10A  
(cont)

PEE WEE

Next years Christmas Special is already booked, too. I might be able to squeeze you in to the Christmas Special two years from now.

SCENE 10  
(cont)

CELEBRITY #1

Oh, would you, please?

SCENE 10A  
(cont)

PEE WEE

I'm not promising you anything now, CELEBRITY #1.

SCENE 10  
(cont)

CELEBRITY #1

I understand. Thanks, Pee-wee. I really appreciate this. Merry Christmas. And I'll see you in two years.

SCENE 10A  
(cont)

PEE WEE

Maybe.

SCENE 10  
(cont)

CELEBRITY #1

Right. Bye.

SCENE 10A  
(cont)

(INT. LIVING ROOM)

SCENE 11

MAGIC SCREEN

Hey, Pee-wee. Now it's time for some  
Christmas fun with me.

PEE WEE

Okay, Magic Screen. Here I come.

(PEE-WEE JUMPS INTO THE  
MAGIC SCREEN)  
(HE REACHES INTO HIS  
POCKETS AND THROWS OUT  
SOME DOTS)

SCENE 11A

PEE WEE

Connect the Christmas dots. Fa-la-la-  
la-la. Connect the Christmas dots. Fa-  
la-la-la-la!

(THE DOTS CONNECT,  
REVEALING A SLEIGH.)

PEE WEE

Hey! It's a sleigh! Just like Santa's!

(PEE-WEE IS CHROMA-KEYED  
INTO SLEIGH RIDE FOOTAGE)

PEE-WEE

Look, there's someone hitch-hiking.

PEE-WEE

Wait a minute. It's Magic Johnson!

(HITCH-HIKING ALONG THE  
SNOWY PATH IS CELEBRITY  
#2)

PEE WEE

SCENE 11A  
(cont)

Magic Johnson?! What are you doing in  
the Magic Screen?

MAGIC JOHNSON

Magic Screen and I are cousins, Pee-  
wee.

PEE WEE

Can I give you a lift?

CELEBRITY #2

Thanks.

(MAGIC JOHNSON JUMPS IN  
AND THE RIDE CONTINUES.)  
(THEY BEGIN TO GO FASTER  
AND FASTER, DOWN A HILL,  
INTO A SPEEDY TOBAGGEN  
TRACK, THEN DOWN A SKI-  
RAMP AND INTO THE AIR.)

PEE WEE

Ahhh! I'm bailing out! See ya, Magic!

MAGIC JOHNSON

Merry Christmas, Pee-wee!

PEE WEE

Merry Christmas!!!!

INT. PLAYHOUSE

SCENE 12

(PEE-WEE LANDS IN  
CHAIRRY)

CHAIRRY

Gotcha!

PEE WEE

Thanks Chairry. Where would I be  
without you?

CHAIRRY

On the floor. Ha. Ha.

PEE WEE

Chairry, you cracked yourself up.

CHAIRRY

Don't you think we should start  
decorating the Playhouse for  
Christmas?

PEE WEE

Decorations?! Oh, no! I was so busy  
making up my list for Santa Claus, I  
completely forgot! We don't have any  
decorations because I was only  
thinking of myself. And Christmas is  
the time we should be thinking about  
what we can do for others. I wish I  
hadn't been so selfish.

(THE DOORS TO JAMBI'S BOX  
SPRING OPEN,)

SCENE 13

JAMBI

Wish, did somebody say wish?

PEE WEE

I did Jambi. I forgot to get decorations for the playhouse. Do you think you can help me out?

JAMBI

Sure, Pee-wee. Is that what you'd like to wish for?

PEE WEE

Well, not really. I'd like to use my wish later for something really special. I was kinda hoping you would give me an extra wish?

JAMBI

An extra wish?! You want an extra wish?! What do you think this is, Christmas?

PEE WEE

Yeah.

JAMBI

Oh...Okay. Then repeat after me...Mecca lekka hi mecca hiney ho...

PEE WEE

Mecca lekka hi mecca hiney ho.

JAMBI

Mecca lekka hi mecca Ho-Ho-Ho.

PEE WEE

SCENE 13  
(cont)

Mecca lekka hi mecca Ho-Ho-Ho.

(JAMBI BLINKS HIS EYES  
AND SUDDENLY...)

(THE ENTIRE PLAYHOUSE IS  
COMPLETELY DECORATED IN  
CHRISTMAS SPLENDOR,  
INCLUDING JAMBI AND HIS  
BOX.)

SCENE 13A

JAMBI

The wish is granted. Long live Jambi.

PEE WEE

Thanks, Jambi.

(JAMBI'S DOORS CLOSE)

MR. WINDOW

SCENE 14

Hey, Pee-wee. Here comes Reba, the  
mail lady.

(REBA ENTERS)

PEE WEE

Hi, Reba. Merry Christmas.

REBA

Merry Christmas, Pee-wee. The  
Playhouse sure does look festive.  
How's the Christmas Special going?

PEE WEE

Great. I think...

(HE LEANS INTO CAMERA)

PEE WEE

How does everyone like it so far?

(HE LISTENS FOR AN  
ANSWER)

PEE WEE

Thanks!...Same to you. Ha. Ha.

REBA

I've got another bag of Christmas  
cards for the playhouse. And here's a  
present from me to you.

(SHE HANDS PEE-WEE A  
PRESENT)

PEE WEE

What is it?

REBA

It's a fruitcake.

(PEE WEE REACTS)

PEE WEE

Thanks. How...thoughtful. Here's a  
little something for you. My most  
recent Christmas list for Santa.

(HE HANDS HER THE LONG  
LIST FROM CONKY)

REBA

How's Santa suppose to get all this  
down that little chimney.

PEE WEE

SCENE 14  
(cont)

I've already thought of that. I'm  
having the chimney expanded. Oh,  
here...This is for you too, Reba.

(HE HANDS HER A GIFT.)

PEE WEE

They're press on nails.

REBA

Why are they so big?

PEE WEE

Cuz they're toe nails.

REBA

Oh. I see. Yeah. Right...Oh! That  
reminds me. Somebody sent you  
something gigantic.

(SHE CALLS O.S.)

REBA

Okay, fellas bring it in.

(TWO MAIL MEN ENTER  
CARRYING WITH A LARGE  
CRATE.)

PEE-WEE

I hope it's not a fruitcake.

(THE FRONT OF THE CRATE  
OPENS AND CELEBRITY #3  
STEPS OUT.)

PEE WEE

Wow! It's CELEBRITY #3!

CELEBRITY #3

SCENE 14  
(cont)

Wait a second, you're not the president. You're Pee-wee Herman.

REBA

Uh-oh. My mistake. This package was suppose to go to the White House. Not the playhouse.

PEE WEE

Sorry, CELEBRITY #3. Back in the box.

CELEBRITY #3

Wait a second. As long as I'm here, would you mind if I sang?

PEE WEE

Go right ahead. What are ya waiting for, Christmas?

(CELEBRITY #3 SINGS)  
(AS THEY FINISH:)

PEE WEE

Thanks a lot, CELEBRITY #3.

CELEBRITY #3

You're welcome, Pee-wee. Merry Christmas, everybody!

ALL

Merry Christmas, CELEBRITY #3!

(AS THE CELEBRITY IS  
CRATED UP: FADE OUT.  
(END ACT ONE)  
(COMMERICAL BREAK)

(ACT 2)  
(INT. PLAYHOUSE BEDROOM)

PEE WEE

Hello. Welcome back to my cool  
Christmas Special. Won't you please  
join me in welcoming my special  
guests, Frankie Avalon and Annette  
Funicello.

PEE WEE

What are you guys doin'?

FRANKIE

We're making Christmas Cards with  
Pterri and Globey.

PEE WEE

You're making Christmas cards? Why not  
just purchase them.

PTERRI

Because, this is more fun.

GLOBEY

And cheaper.

ANNETTE

I'm using a stencil process. The  
stencil I'm using looks like a  
Christmas tree. I lay it down on the  
card, dip my toothbrush into some

green paint and brush it across this piece of screen. Look, isn't it pretty?

PEE WEE

Yeah...I hope you remeber to clean that toothbrush before you brush your teeth.

ANNETTE

That's a good idea.

(ANNETTE SMILES REVEALING HER TEETH COVERED WITH GREEN PAINT)

PEE-WEE

And what are you making Frankie?

FRANKIE

I'm making cards using a potato!

PEE WEE

You say potato and I say potato. Ha.  
Ha.

FRANKIE

First I cut a candy cane shape out of the potato...like this. Then, I simply dip it into some red paint and print it onto the paper. A candy cane! See?

PEE WEE

Mmm. Potato-ey.

## FLOWERS

SCENE 17

Pee-wee, the King of Cartoons is  
coming.

(THE FLOWERS SING THE  
KING'S INTRO.)  
(THE KING ENTERS)

KING

SCENE 17A

Happy Holidays, everyone! Pee-wee, I  
brought you present.

PEE WEE

It isn't a fruit cake is it?

KING

No...

(PEE-WEE REACTS RELIEVED)  
(THE KING HANDS HIM TWO  
WRAPPED PRESENTS.)

KING

It's two fruitcakes!

PEE WEE

Oh, they can keep each other company.

(ANNETTE COMES OVER.)

ANNETTE

Excuse me. Your Majesty, would you  
mind if I said it just this once.

KING

Certainly, Annette.

ANNETTE

I've always wanted to do this..."Let

the cartoon...Begin!"

(ANNETTE PRESSES THE  
ROYAL REMOTE CONTROL.)

SCENE 17B

(ON THE T.V.)  
(JOAN RIVERS, APPEARS ON  
THE HOLLYWOOD SQUARES.)

JOAN RIVERS (ON T.V.)

...Sure, but I wouldn't try it with a  
bar of soap!

PEE WEE

SCENE 17A

Look! There's Joan Rivers!

JOAN RIVERS (ON T.V.)

SCENE 17B

Hi, Pee-wee. Happy Holidays!

PEE WEE

SCENE 17A

Thanks.

(ANNETTE PRESSES THE  
REMOTE CONTROL AGAIN AND  
THE CARTOON BEGINS.)

(THE CARTOON PLAYS)

INT. PLAYHOUSE  
(WHEN THE CARTOON IS  
OVER, BILLY BALONEY TALKS  
TO CAMERA.)

SCENE 18

BILLY BALONEY

Hi, everybody. Pee-wee's not here  
right now, so now it's the Billy  
Baloney Christmas Special. Starring  
me, Billy Baloney. Now I'd like to  
sing a little song for all my adoring  
fans. Me-me-me-me-me.

(BILLY BEGINS TO SING  
SCALES.)

SCENE 18  
(cont)

(CAMERA WIDENS REVEALING  
PEE-WEE OPERATING BILLY.)

PEE WEE

Okay, Billy. I'm back now.

BILLY

No. Go away. I want to sing.

PEE WEE

Sorry, Billy.

BILLY

Not as sorry as I am.

PEE WEE

Maybe next year.

(EVERYONE IN THE  
PLAYHOUSE SCREAMS.)

(EXT. ABOVE THE  
PLAYHOUSE)

SCENE 19

(SNOW BEGINS TO FALL ON  
MR. KITE.)

MR. KITE

Weather alert! Weather alert! It's  
starting to snow.

(INT. PLAYHOUSE)

SCENE 20

(PEE WEE RUNS AROUND THE  
PLAYHOUSE SCREAMING.)

PEE WEE

It's snowing! It's snowing! It's  
snowing!

(MUSIC COMES UP AND PEE-  
WEE BEGINS TO SING. AS HE  
DOES HE PUTS ON GALOSHES  
AND MITTENS.)

PEE WEE  
(singing)  
Ohhh! The weather outside is  
frightful. But I find it most  
delightful. Cuz it's perfect for the  
show...Let it snow. Let it snow. Let  
it snow!

(PEE WEE STEPS INTO A  
CLOSET AND COMES OUT SO  
BUNDLED UP HE CAN BARELY  
MOVE.)

PEE WEE  
Let's go outside and play in the snow!

Snow! Snow! Ahhh! Yellow snow! Ha. Ha.

Look out, Mr. Window. Here comes a  
snowball!

(INT. PLAYHOUSE)

SCENE 21A

(MR. WINDOW OPENS AND THE  
SNOWBALL FLIES INTO THE  
PLAYHOUSE AND INTO THE  
DINASOUR HOLE.)

(INT. DINOSAUR HOLE)

SCENE 21B

(THE DINOSAURS HAVE A  
SNOWBALL FIGHT WITH ONE  
ANOTHER)

(EXT. SNOWY SETTING)

SCENE 22

PEE-WEE

Watch, I'm going to make a snow angel.

(PEE-WEE FALLS BACK IN A  
SNOWDRIFT AND BEGINS  
FLAILING HIS ARMS AND  
LEGS. AS HE GETS UP:

PEE WEE

Look. I made an angel in the snow!

(THERE IS A BEAUTIFUL  
IMAGE ON AN ANGEL MADE IN  
THE SNOW.

PEE WEE

Now I'm going to make mystery tracks  
in the snow. See, I walk through the  
snow, then I retrace my own steps and

it looks like whoever it was suddenly disappeared.

SCENE 22  
(cont)

COWBOY CURTIS (O.C.)

Pee-wee!

PEE WEE

Over here, Cowboy Curtis! Just follow my footprints in the snow! Ha. ha.

(PEE WEE HIDES AS COWBOY CURTIS FOLLOWS PEE-WEE'S PRINTS IN THE SNOW UNTIL THEY SUDDENLY STOP.)

SCENE 23

COWBOY CURTIS

Huh? Hey, where did he go?

(PEE-WEE JUMPS OUT SURPRISING COWBOY CURTIS.)

PEE WEE

Ahhhh! Here I am! I fooled you with the mystery tracks in the snow...Ooooh, mysterious.

COWBOY CURTIS

You shore did, Pee-wee.

(PEE-WEE HEARS MUSIC.)

PEE WEE

Listen. Do you hear that, Cowboy Curtis? That's the heavenly intonations of "The Del Rubio Triplets!

(CAMERA MOVES PAST PEE-

WEE TO THE SINGING DEL  
RUBIO SISTERS, (#8) WHO  
PERFORM "WALKING IN A  
WINTER WONDERLAND."  
(THEY FINISH THEIR NUMBER  
AND WALK OFF.)

SCENE 23B

(PEE-WEE AND COWBOY

Dirty Dog, your such a cute pup.

Your welcome, K.D., that's why we're

(EVERYONE SCREAMS.)

(ANGLE ON THE FIREPLACE)

(PEE-WEE IS HANGING UP

PEE WEE

Here's Globey's. And Magic Screens.

And here's yours Pterri.

PTERRI

I love my Christmas stocking.

PEE WEE

Then why don't you marry it?

(RANDY DROPS DOWN.)

RANDY

What are ya doin', Pee-wee. Hanging up  
the laundry?

PEE WEE

No, Randy. I'm hanging up everyone's  
Christmas stockings.

PTERRI

And Santa Claus is going to come and  
fill them up with Christmas treats.

RANDY

Santa Claus?! There ain't no such

COUNTESS

Guess.

(PEE-WEE TAKES THE GIFT  
FROM AROUND HER NECK.)

PEE WEE

(TO CAMERA)

(TO COUNTESS)

Is it a fruitcake?

COUNTESS

SCENE 30

(cont)

Hang on, Celebrity #12. I've got  
another call.

(PEE-WEE PUSHES A BUTTON  
PUTTING CELEBRITY #12 ON  
HOLD. AS CELEBRITY #13  
APPEARS ON THE SCREEN,  
CELEBRITY #12 IS SEEN IN  
THE UPPER CORNER OF THE

SCREEN STILL SINGING.

CELEBRITY #13

SCENE 31B

Hi, Pee-wee.

PEE WEE

SCENE 31  
(cont)

Merry Christmas, CELEBRITY #13. I'm going to have to call you back. I've got CELEBRITY #12 on the other line.

CELEBRITY #13

SCENE 31B  
(cont)

Okay. I just wanted to wish you a very, Merry Christmas.

PEE WEE

SCENE 31  
(cont)

Thanks.

(AS CELEBRITY #13 SNAPS OFF, PEE-WEE PULLS A DUMMY OF HIMSELF TO THE PICTURE PHONE. CELEBRITY #12, WHO IS STILL SINGING, COMES BACK ON.)

INT. PLAYHOUSE

SCENE 32

(ANGLE ON GLOBEY SPINNING AS MARCHING MUSIC PLAYS UNDER.)

GLOBEY

And now it's time for Christmas around the world! Pick a country Pee-wee.

PEE WEE

Uh...Yugoslavia.

(AS GLOBEY NARRATES, ILLUSTRATIONS OF CHRISTMAS IN OTHER LANDS APPEAR.)

GLOBEY

SCENE 32  
(cont)

In Yugoslavia, the second Sunday before Christmas is know as Mother's Day. Mother must pretend not to notice when one of the children slips in cautiously and ties her feet to her chair. The rest of the children then rusn in shouting, "Mother's Day. Mother's Day, what will you pay to get away?" Mother gives the children the Christmas presents she has for them and is released. On the following Sunday, Father gets the same treatment.

PEE WEE

Wow! In Yugolslavia ya get to tie up your parents!...Hey, Globey. How about Christmas in England.

GLOBEY

Blazing plum pudding, a crackling yule log and rosy cheeched children are symbols of English Christmas cheer. An English Christmas food is mince pie. It has a long history. A recipe, dated 1344, required the chopped meats of pheasant, partridges and hares.

PEE WEE

SCENE 32  
(cont)

Ew! They put hairs in the pie?! No pie  
for me please! Ha. Ha.

(RICARDO ENTERS.)

SCENE 33

RICARDO

Feliz Navidad, Pee-wee. That means  
Merry Christmas in Spanish. Say it,  
"Feliz Navidad."

PEE WEE

Fleas. Na-me-na-me-la.

RICARDO

Right! Children in Mexico celebrate  
Christmas by breaking the pinata.

PEE WEE

Gosh! You get to break things on  
Christmas!?

RICARDO

Look Pee-wee. I hung a pinata from the  
ceiling of the Playhouse.

(A CRAZY LOOKING PINATA  
HANGS OVER HIS HEAD.)

RICARDO

It's filled with sweets and toys.

PEE WEE

How are we going to get it down?

RICARDO

SCENE 33  
(cont)

That's the fun part Pee-wee. I'm going to blind fold you and you're going to try to break it open with this stick.

PEE WEE

This is going to be fun. Now, the only thing missing is Charo.

(CHARO, CELEBRITY #14, IS SITTING ON A STOOL WITH A GUITAR NEXT TO CONKY.)

SCENE 34

#14 CHARO

Hit it, Conky!

(CONKY GIVES CHARO A RYTHM BOX BACKGROUND)

(CHARO SINGS "FELIZ NAVIDA...")

(AS SHE FINISHES THE SONG, PEE-WEE TRIES TO BREAK THE PINATA. FINALLY, PEE-WEE HITS THE PINATA.)

THE PLAYHOUSE IS SHOWERED WITH SPECIAL EFFECTS TREATS.)

SCENE 34A

PEE WEE

SCENE 34B

Pinata!!!

CHAIRRY

That was really beautiful, Charo.

#14 CHARO

Thank you, Chairy.

PEE WEE

SCENE 34B  
(cont)

Chairy. Charo. Chairy. Charo.

#14 CHARO

Gracias, Pee-wee. I am so happy. You know, I have a resteraunt in Hawaii.

PEE WEE

Where?

#14 CHARO

Hawaii.

PEE WEE

Oh, Hawaii!

#14 CHARO

That's what I said, Hawaii.

And so I made you a special dish just for Christmas. It's very, very, very good. It's called, pastel de fruta.

PEE WEE

Sounds great, what is it?

#14 CHARO

KITCHEN AND PUTS IT ON A

I sure have gotten a lot of fruitcakes

Could you use one more?

So in case I miss you, here's seven more fruitcakes.

(SHE HANDS HIM MORE FRUITCAKES.)

(PEE-WEE REACTS.)

(ACT 4)

SCENE 36

(INT. PLAYHOUSE)

(THE REGULARS AND GUESTS  
ARE DECORATING THE  
CHRISTMAS TREE.)

PEE WEE

Welcome back, we're just finishing  
decorating the Christmas tree.

(EVERYONE STEPS BACK  
REVEALING THE CRAZIEST  
LOOKING CHRISTMAS TREE  
EVER.)

(PTERRI FLIES OVER WITH A  
STAR AND PUTS IT ON THE  
CHRISTMAS TREE.)

(EVERYONE "OOHS AND AAHS"

Magic Screen, will you assist me?

MAGIC SCREEN

Sure.

(ON THE MAGIC SCREEN IS A FIFTIES CHILDRENS FILM REINACTING THE BIRTH OF CHRIST WITH CHILDREN PLAYING THE WISE MEN, MARY, JOSEPH, ETC.)

(PEE-WEE NARRATES THE FILM O.C.)

PEE WEE

(NARRATION TO COME)

(THE FILM ENDS.)

SCENE 36  
(cont)

SCENE 36A

PEE WEE

And that, is the true meaning of  
Christmas.

RANDY

Gee, I had Christmas all wrong. Thanks  
for straightening me out.

PEE WEE

You're welcome, Randy.
