TILT UP as Zondal begins to move. Speed up ZOOM OUT as Zondal makes big move to include Varga L of frame

BEYOND THEM, AT THE BACK OF THE RECESS, IS A SUGGESTION OF AN OPENING, OR NATURAL FLAW IN THE ICE, WHICH LATER WILL EXPAND INTO THE INNER SECTION OF THE CAVE, LEADING TO THE SPACESHIP DOOR.

WE COME UP ON VARGA AS HE POINTS TO ZONDAL WHO IS JUST BEGINNING TO COME TO LIFE.

VARGA: Look! (HE POINTS TO ZONDAL) It is working - Zondal is coming to life.

(CUT TO VICTORIA'S AWE-STRUCK FACE AND BACK TO VARGA AS HE CROSSES TO STAND BY ZONDAL. HE REPEATS HIS NAME IN A CRESCENDO OF SOUND, AS IF TO URGE HIM MORE QUICKLY INTO LIFE)

VARGA: Zondal, Zondal, Zondal (etc., etc.)

(VARGA'S MEN ARE DRESSED LIKE HIM, BUT WITH SLIGHT DIFFERENCES TO DENOTE LESSER RANK, EXCEPT THE FIRST ONE - ZONDAL, VARGA'S 2 I/C.

HE HAS NONE OF VARGA'S DRY HUMOUR, AND IS ALTOGETHER MORE SOUR AND BELIGERENT.

FROM BEHIND AN OUTCROP OF ICE, PENLEY WATCHES AMAZED.) (MUSIC 25A)
