ODYSSEUS: I was just thinking that with any luck either Achilles or Agamemnon will not come through.

DOCTOR: You mean they'll desert us?

ODYSSEUS: No. Die - just a hope. One less finger in the pie. A greater share of the booty.

DOCTOR: That is a most immoral way of looking at life!

On 2: Shot 43

ODYSSEUS: Nonsense. That's the only reason I stayed here all these years.

DOCTOR: I must get out of here at once.

ODYSSEUS: You can't!

DOCTOR: If I pull this lever, I can get down into the square.

ODYSSEUS: Yes. But as I'm sitting on the rope, you'll probably break your neck by falling forty feet.

DOCTOR: I will not be a party to your schemes! You forced me to invent this contraption

ODYSSEUS: I'm glad I did - it's proved highly satisfactory.

DOCTOR: But there was no reason to bring me with you. I'm no use to you here.

(ODYSSEUS LAUGHS)

DOCTOR: (EXPLODING) You must let me out! Your attitude to life is disgusting, and I want nothing of it. You are selfish, greedy and corrupt - your only thought is what's in it for you!!

ODYSSEUS: Be quiet!

DOCTOR: I will not be quiet. I will warn the Trojans that we're here unless you let me out. You can stay and win your insignificant victory, but I will not.

ODYSSEUS: Another word and I'll kill you. You can be my first victim in Troy.

(DOCTOR REALISES HE CANNOT REASON WITH THIS MAN. WITH CONTEMPT HE GOES AND SITS)

ODYSSEUS: That's better.
(LAUGHS) Don't worry. It's about
