BRIEF OUTLINE OF PLOT (Information in brackets NOT FOR PUBLICATION)

A group of palaeontologists led by PROFESSOR KYLE, have been savagely attacked while studying fossil remains deep in a newly discovered cave system. KYLE, the only survivor of the party has managed to summon help in the shape of LIEUTENANT SCOTT and his troopers.

Meanwhile, on board the Tardis, ADRIC has declared the desire to return home. As this would mean returning to E-space, the DOCTOR is reluctant, but ADRIC is adamant, saying he will plot a course. While ADRIC does this, the DOCTOR materialises the Tardis underground on 25th century Earth. Exploring the caves, the DOCTOR finds impressive fossilised dinosaur remains. He tells the companions that the dinosaur had literally died out overnight, their demise probably caused by Earth's collision with an enormous object from space. The impact had caused massive amounts of dust to be hurled up into the atmosphere, blocking out the sun and causing the surface temperature of the planet to rapidly drop. The reptile dinosaurs couldn't cope.

The journey underground has proved difficult for KYLE and the troopers, several of their number having been killed by an unseen force. When they reach the main cavern, the place of the palaeontologist's massacre, they find the DOCTOR and COMPANIONS. SCOTT assumes them responsible, but during his questioning, they are attacked by two androids, (controlled from their base by CYBERMEN.)

The androids are eventually destroyed, but not before a signal they are transmitting to their base is traced by the DOCTOR. The DOCTOR also discovers a metal hatch built into the wall of the cave. When opened, it is found to contain a massive bomb which the DOCTOR deactivates.

SCOTT and KYLE join the DOCTOR in their journey to the source of the transmission. The Tardis materialises on board a massive Earth bound freighter. The DOCTOR and ADRIC are soon captured and questioned by BRIGGS, BERGER and RINGWAY concerning the disappearance and murder of several of their crew.

(With the DOCTOR a prisoner, the CYBERMEN decide to secure the freighter for themselves. From their base deep in the hold, the CYBERMEN emerge and soon the ship is theirs. The DOCTOR learns that as he has deactivated their bomb, the freighter is to be used as a massive missile.



He also learns from the CYBERLEADER that an interplanetary conference is being held on Earth where a pact will be signed uniting their forces against the CYBERMEN. CYBERLEADER cannot allow this to happen. The conference must be destroyed.

The freighter is locked into a course for Earth and the DOCTOR forced to take CYBERLEADER on board the Tardis. ADRIC is left with the crew and after overpowering their guards, they struggle to divert the collision. But such is the nature of the Cyber device controlling the freighter, ADRIC only succeeds in forcing the ship into a reverse warp, sending it backwards in time, but still heading for Earth.

Unable to do any more, BRIGGS and crew abandon ship, but ADRIC stays on board believing he can still change the freighter's course. But he is too late. The ship, with ADRIC on board, crashes into Earth. The DOCTOR and COMPANIONS watch from the Tardis. TEGAN is distraught, not only because of ADRIC's death, but because of the effect it will have on her own history. The DOCTOR points out that they have travelled back to the time when the dinosaurs died out - the freighter was the object that collided with Earth. What will follow is the history of Earth as Tegan knows it. Earth is safe. The CYBERMEN on board the Tardis are overwhelmed, but that hardly compensates for the death of ADRIC.)

the pulse of the
heart beat. Everything
else is excluded.

Life forms appear on the
scanner screen as
dots of light. If
the person moves,
so does the dot.
If the person dies,
the light goes out.

The scanner also has a
built in-computer to
calculate position of
located life-form.
Information is fed into
the computer

Via a conventional
typewriter keyboard.

The screen of the scanner
is heavily cowled to
block out daylight.

Seated at the scanner
control is WALTERS.
To one side is TROOPER
SNYDER.

WALTERS is male, SNYDER
is female.

Both TROOPERS are in
their mid-twenties, friendly
and eager.

LIEUTENANT SCOTT and KYLE
join SERGEANT MITCHELL
at the cave entrance.

SCOTT is about forty,
authoritative and fairly
positive in his attitudes.

MITCHELL is in her early thirties, an attractive, likeable woman. She never barks her orders but delivers them in a firm loud voice, her authority assured.

PROFESSOR KYLE is in her late thirties, an attractive and neat woman, who is completely overwhelmed with what is going on around her.

All but KYLE are in uniform. KYLE wears overalls and boots suitable for scrambling about in caves.

The screen of the scanner is blank, apart from the arc of ten PROBERS standing in front of the cave.

MITCHELL: Nothing.

KYLE turns back towards WALTERS and SNYDER who are erecting the scanner.

KYLE: How does this thing work?
