He picks up the pyramid and gently sets it down in the circle of spheres and backs away. The pyramid starts to glow (b) <u>EXT. CAVE. DAY</u> TRAVERS is still trapped by the proximity of the YETI (1), (2), (3) and (4). He watches SONGSTEN come out of the cave. The THREE YETI form up around him and the group moves off. TRAVERS as soon as the coast is clear, moves towards the cave. (c) <u>EXT. TARDIS. DAY</u> DOCTOR and JAMIE watching the motionless YETI(1). DOCTOR throws a rock at the YETI. It remains motionless. DOCTOR goes up to it and removes the sphere. He then goes into the Tardis. (d) <u>INT. CAVE. DAY</u> TRAVERS enters the main chamber of the cave. He sees the pyramid - flickering light and high-pitched note. Light and sound increase in pitch. TRAVERS staggers back, clasping his hands to his ears. He falls to the ground. TRAVERS crawls feebly away. (e) <u>EXT. TARDIS. DAY</u> JAMIE waiting outside the Tardis for DOCTOR. He holds the sphere, which suddenly sends out a high-pitched intermittent signal. DOCTOR comes from Tardis holding a small box piece of equipment (tracking device). They move off.

A MOMENT OF STILLNESS.

11) 1 A (35) / MS THONMI

IN THE DISTANCE WE CAN HEAR VICTORIA AND SAPAN CALLING "Khrisong! Khrisong!" OUT ("Khrisong! Khrisong!") AS THE YETI MOVES OFF IN THE DIRECTION OF THEIR VOICES.

Pan him L. to statue

SAPAN: It is alive!

KHRISONG: What!

VICTORIA from b/g

SHAKEN OFF. THONMI HURRIES
TOWARDS VICTORIA)

SAPAN: (CRYING OUT) We will all
be killed!

THONMI: Open the gates!

(VICTORIA AND THONMI RUSH
TO THE GATE AND STRUGGLE
TO OPEN IT. KHRISONG HAS
HURLED HIMSELF BACK INTO
THE FIGHT. THE YETI BURSTS

Jamie looks at him quizzically

DOCTOR: It's all too quiet.
There's not been a sign of Yeti
since we saw those three back
there.

JAMIE: Aye, well let's just be
grateful and get to the Tardis.

DOCTOR: Mm ... don't like it.
There's something happening on
this mountain I can feel it.

He looks round and shivers
slightly.

JAMIE: You're giving me the
willies ... Come on ...

The Doctor grins

TELECINE 2: (SC. 9) (cont.)

EXT. CAVE. DAY

(TWO YETI, ONE OF WHICH
CARRIES THE SPHERE,
APPROACH THE CAVE
ENTRANCE. TRAVERS APPEARS
IN FOREGROUND OF SHOT,
WATCHING THEM FURTIVELY)

THE YETI, HOWEVER, DO NOT
ENTER THE CAVE. THE ONE
CARRYING THE SPHERE, STATIONS
ITSELF AT THE ENTRANCE TO
THE CAVE. AFTER A BRIEF
PAUSE, THE OTHER ONE MOVES
OFF DOWN THE MOUNTAIN.
TRAVERS IS PUZZLED BY THIS
BEHAVIOUR. HE TURNS HIS
HEAD, AND WITH A LOOK OF
HORROR, HE BACKS AWAY AND
HIDES BEHIND A NEARBY ROCK.
INTO THE FOREGROUND MARCH
THE THREE YETI AND
SONGTSEN.

C.U. TRAVERS AMAZED AND
HORRIFIED TO SEE SONGTSEN
WITH THE YETI.

SONGTSEN APPROACHES THE
CAVE, TAKES THE SPHERE
FROM THE WAITING YETI,
WHICH TURNS AND GOES.
SONGTSEN ENTERS THE CAVE.
THE OTHER THREE YETI
STATION THEMSELVES IN A
SEMI-CIRCLE FACING THE
ENTRANCE. ONE OF THEM IS
NOW STANDING CLOSE TO
TRAVERS, WHO DARE NOT
MOVE FOR FEAR OF DISCOVERY.

EXT. TARDIS. DAY.

THE DOCTOR AND JAMIE ARE
ROUNDING A ROCK AS THEY
APPROACH THE TARDIS.

JAMIE: Doctor Look!

TELECINE 2 (CONT'D)

THEY COME OUT INTO THE OPEN, BUT IMMEDIATELY FREEZE AS THEY SEE A YETI STANDING MOTIONLESS BY THE TARDIS. THE DOCTOR TAPS JAMIE ON THE ARM AND THEY RETREAT HURRIEDLY BEHIND THE ROCK.

DOCTOR: Thought we'd been too lucky ...

JAMIE: (WHISPERING) What now?

DOCTOR: (THINKING) Don't know .. but we've got to get into the Tardis somehow ...

JAMIE: Well, you canna' frighten one of these things off.

DOCTOR: (THOUGHTFULLY) No ...

JAMIE: I wonder what it's waiting there for?

DOCTOR: (DEEP IN THOUGHT) Hm?

JAMIE: I mean ... it can't have known we were coming.

DOCTOR: It's robot Jamie. It merely follows instructions.

JAMIE: Aye. But who's giving them?

DOCTOR: Hm. We'll have to find out won't we?

Quite unexpectedly the Doctor stands up in view of the Yeti.

JAMIE: (HORRIFIED) Get down Doctor!

DOCTOR: (TO HIMSELF) Yes

JAMIE: (KEENLY) Have you thought
out some clever plan Doctor?

DOCTOR: (PLEASED WITH HIMSELF)
Yes ... I think I have.

JAMIE: Well, what are you
doing to do?

DOCTOR: (SIMPLY) Bung a rock
at it!

JAMIE: Och, will you no' be
serious Doctor.

TELECINE 3 (CONT'D)

DOCTOR: (QUICKLY PICKS UP A ROCK)
Oh, but I am.

He throws it at the
Yeti. Jamie is
horrified.

JAMIE: Doctor!!

Jamie gets ready to
run. The Doctor puts
out a hand to hold him
back. For a moment
they remain motionless
watching the Yeti. It
doesn't move.

DOCTOR: Hm ... just as I thought.
Can't see, can't feel - come on.

He starts to move towards
the Yeti. Jamie tries to
stop him.

JAMIE: Don't be daft, Doctor.

DOCTOR: It's quite alright Jamie.
Just like the other three we saw.
Either switched off or not
receiving.

They are now almost up
to the Yeti.

JAMIE: (HESITANTLY) Are you
sure it's safe?

DOCTOR: Quite frankly .. no. But
we'll soon find out.

He goes right up to it
and touches it gently.
Jamie is prudently holding
back.

JAMIE: Don't be daft, Doctor.
You might switch it on.

DOCTOR: Mm? ...No, I don't think
so.

(CONT'D)

TELECINE (CONT'D)

The Doctor leans forward and listens at its chest.

DOCTOR: (SATISFIED) Yes, just as I thought

He rumages in his pocket, produces a screw-driver and turns back to the Yeti.

The Doctor grunts and continues to fumble with the chest of the Yeti. After a moment he succeeds in opening the flap.

DOCTOR: Jamie ... Come and hold this flap open ...

JAMIE: (AGHAST) You're taking an awful risk, Doctor.

Jamie does so. The Doctor slips the screw-driver back in his pocket. With infinite care, like defusing a mine, the Doctor uses both hands and gently removes the sphere. With a sigh of relief they both move away.

DOCTOR: Well I'm glad that's over. (HE TOSSES THE SPHERE TO JAMIE) Catch!

JAMIE: (PUZZLED) Here Doctor, there's something I don't understand.

DOCTOR: What's that?

JAMIE: Well whoever made these robots is pretty clever, right?

DOCTOR: Yes....

JAMIE: And yet you've been able to put it out of action just like that.
